### Non Public

BA motions to move into non-public session per RSA 91-A:3, II(a) at 6:54pm. PS seconds. All in favor.

AG motions to move out of non-public session and into public at 7:16pm. BA seconds. All in favor.

Vote to seal the minutes of the non-public session *under RSA 91-A:3, II(a):The dismissal,* promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a public meeting, and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted. PS motions to approve, AG seconds. All others in favor. None opposed.

### Facilities, Strategic Planning

- JW presented plan for the future & Sustainability; the plan to be voted on is the 12,000 square feet expansion where Bull Moose is now. Entrance would move to the Bull Moose front.
- This is the first step in a "Path to Ownership" of the building. Other than Bull Moose, will retain existing tenants with leases
- September Implementation is the goal for the first floor space.
- PS & AH & CS have been working with and will continue to work with an architect on what potential space would look like. Looking at multiple options of layout including:
  - Gym would be multipurpose.
  - Secondary entrance would be drop off for all.
  - Nurses office would be in a prevalent area next to outdoor space, Upper Elementary would be upstairs
  - 2nd Art teacher/ 2nd Art Room.
  - o Science wing.
  - o Back of the building and adding in drop in windows.
  - Indoor Playground (2nd/3rd year process)
  - Add tutor rooms and tech lab STEAM space

- Single Stall bathrooms to be more gender neutral
- Eventually updating upstairs bathrooms
- Communicating Space- Open to below. More natural light.
- o Grand Staircase in the back. Prioritizing updates and what will be fundraised for.
- Multi faceted project over the years, will get multiple bids
- Existing lighting will be swapped over to LED. All new spaces will have LED lighting.
- Press release going out to staff, then to parents, then have web page FAQs to be launched February 14 at 10am.

BA motioned to adopt the 5th amendment to the lease. AR Seconds. All in Favor. N.ne Opposed.
